Assembly of the first wind turbine in Brazil on the Areia Branca site

In accordance with its development plan (cf. mainly the press release of June 23rd, 2014), Voltalia advances on its Brazilian worksites.



A new stage has just been accomplished on the first of its worksites, the site of Areia Branca, where the first nacelle has been put-up on top of the 120 metre tower.

Progressively, the 30 wind turbines of 3MW each are thus equipped with their nacelles, thanks to the mobilization of more than 600 people currently working on site.

Regrouping three wind farms, the worksite of Areia Branca is progressing according to schedule, with 30MW that will be put in service for the third trimester of 2014 and 60MW for the fourth trimester of 2014.

Those three wind farms, located in one of the windiest locations in the world, will them alone permit to increase Voltalia's installed capacity by 171%.
